CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Edgar R. Johnson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Walley's Hot Spring through pump, pressure tank, and distribution system for commercial purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T. 13N., R. 19E., or at points from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 22 bears N. 16° 30' W., 860 feet; N. 14° 00' W., 940 feet; and N. 31° 00' W., 960 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.067 c.f.s. but not to exceed 15.77 mg. per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 13, 1962

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is collected by means of collection boxes, then pumped with a 1 hp pump to a pressure tank, thence by distribution system to the place of use located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T. 13N., R. 19E., where it is used for commercial purposes (4 cottages, pool, bar, and restaurant.)

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
