CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Leonard A. Frechette has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, and pipelines for

Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T. 20S., R. 60E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 24 bears S. 52° 33' E., a distance of 801.4 feet.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 221.020, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Leonard A. Frechette
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.73 mg annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 15, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a well and is conveyed by means of a distribution system to two houses where it is used for quasi-municipal purposes within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
