CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. V. Caselli - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 15 bears S. 45° 00' W., a distance of 1,832.4 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 4.31 c.f.s. but not to exceed 640 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation July 11, 1960

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
160 acres in the SE 1/4 of Section 15, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 19000, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 19000.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
