CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 23N., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 32 bears S. 35° 58' E., a distance of 561 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

160 acres in the SE 1/4 of Section 32, T. 23N., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 19144 hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 19144.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
