CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Thomas L. Clay has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 25, T.2S., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 51° 21' W. a distance of 2,202.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Thomas L. Clay
Post-office address: Caliente, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.88 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1173.5 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 30th, 1961

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acfe feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
