CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William Boyd has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well and pumped to pressure tank for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 28 bears S. 57° 38' 30" W., a distance of 488.1 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of ~~NRS 531.425~~, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 27, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a 10 inch diameter drilled well and pumped to a pressure tank for distribution to three (3) residences for domestic purposes within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
