CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Jack K. Leavitt (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mance spring and tributaries through unnamed pipeline and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 21 S., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 3 bears N. 24° 30' W., a distance of 2340.0 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
*Date of priority of appropriation as decreed

This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of water under Proof 02287 certificate 339, Mance spring decree; hence the priority of appropriation for the land under this certificate is the same as decreed under Proof 02287. This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
