CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS S. L. Suskelly, Acting Regional Forester / has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Angel Creek Campground spring through spring, collection box and distribution system for domestic (public campground) and stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 36 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 2, T. 36 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 7° 18' W. a distance of 2,076 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.11 cfs but not to exceed 1,735 mg per season
Period of use, from April 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 15, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced from a spring through a system of perforated pipes into a collection box, thence conveyed by pipe to a 2,000 gallon storage tank. Thence by pipe line to the campground located within portions of the SE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 36 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is to be used for domestic (Public Campground) and stockwatering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
