CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. L. Cord has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the corner common to sections 27, 28, 33, and 34 bears S. 84° 46' 26" W., a distance of 1,270.45 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: E. L. Cord
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.12 cfs but not to exceed 810.65 ac. ft. annually.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 15, 1960

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
