CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. R. Caldwell - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and pressure tank for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 44 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 23, bears S. 72° 58' 44" E., a distance of 1,941.02 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Topeka, Kansas
Amount of appropriation 0.00223 cfs but not to exceed 1440 gallons per day
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 1st, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from an 8" dia. well with a submersible pump to a pressure tank and used for domestic purposes in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
