CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Art Leavitt & Rita Leavitt has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Meadow Valley Wash through diversion dam and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T. 12 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears N. 29° 45' 00" W., a distance of 1,690 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

20 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, T. 12 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
