CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from outfall of the Ely City Sewer System through Sewer outfall ditch for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 10 bears S. 46° 30' 36" W., a distance of 2044 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: .55 cfs but not to exceed 1115.55 ac. ft. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 23, 1954

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
