CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James A. Rankin has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Clear Creek through diversion weir, concrete pipe, and irrigation system for stockwatering, irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 14 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 1 bears N. 51° 34' E., a distance of 1920.9 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate changes the point of diversion of water under the Clear Creek decree Case 1020, State of Nevada, in District Court, Second Judicial District County of Ormsby July 22, 1872. Hence the date of priority of appropriation for this certificate is the same as decreed. This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
