

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Julio McErquiaga has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through collection works, pipeline and troughs for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 5, Sec. 6, T. 46 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of Section 11, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., bears S. 59° 44' W., a distance of 6,286.0 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation .0097 cfs or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 10 head of horses.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 18, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a small earthen dam, fed by a spring and conveyed through a 1" pipeline to a 20' diameter trough located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 46 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water 300 head of cattle and 10 head of horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
