CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William J. Johnstone (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 34 bears N. 59° 10' 44" E., a distance of 1502.82 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 5.4 cfs but not to exceed a duty of 1.970.27 ac. ft. per season
Period of use, from: April 1st to October 1st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: May 6, 1960

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 18808, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 18808. This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
