CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through open cut, collecting tank and pump for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 1S., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 7, T. 1S., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 68° 07' E., a distance of 1,480 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.03 cfs but not to exceed 7.069 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 10, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use
water is developed by means of a 6 foot wide, by 12 foot deep open cut at the bottom of the wash. A large water collecting tank is placed in the cut. From the large tank, water is pumped into 50 gallon barrels where it is used for drilling, and washing ore on a table.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
