

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Ed's Well) through well, pump, and watering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 3 N., R. 53 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36, T. 3 N., R. 53 E., M. D. B. & M., bears S. 64° 44' E., a distance of 9817.30 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Joe Fallini and Pat and Virginia McGuin

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.002 cfs. or sufficient to water 1,000 cattle and 25 horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation January 12, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is developed by means of a 108 feet dug well and a 204' drilled well equipped with a windmill, gasoline engine and pump. Water is conveyed to two watering troughs 15 feet long and 29" wide and 16" deep. The place of use is in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 35, T. 3 N., R. 53 E., M. D. B. & M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit No. 11049, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 11049.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
