CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears N. 44° 57' E. a distance of 1879.0 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 4.233 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1280 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation May 18, 1960

Description of Land to which water is appurtenant:
320 acres in the E 1/4 of Section 10, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 18857, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 18857.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
