CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mrs. Charles H. Branstetter, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dabute Tunnel Spring through pump and pipeline for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T. 11 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 10 bears S. 85° 57' 08" W., a distance of 2,691.72 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation .93 cfs but not to exceed 7.077 mg. per year
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 23, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use
Water is collected in a sump at the Dabute tunnel portal and then pumped through a pipeline to the place of use within Sec. 10, T. 11 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to supply domestic water to a mine camp.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
