CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mrs. Charles H. Branstetter, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Carter Station Spring through pump and pipeline for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 11 N., R. 21 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the North 1/4 corner of said Section 9 bears N. 66° 49' 55" W., a distance of 772.92 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.06 cfs but not to exceed 14.154 mg per year

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 23rd 1962

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use
Water is pumped through a pipeline to the place located within Section 10, T. 11 N., R. 21 E., M. D. B. & M., where it is used for mining, milling, and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
