CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 17 bears S. 45° 00' W., a distance of 1850 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Marshall J. & Barbara R. Stenton, husband and wife; Neil D. Stenton, a Name of appropriator. Single man; and Frederick G. Stenton, a single man
