CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ernest E. Muller (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Poison Creek and tributaries through open ditches and pipeline for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 2, T. 25 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 35, T. 26 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 51° 40' E., a distance of 454 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
