CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert J. Fischer (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed spring through pump and pipe line for recreation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 17, T. 5 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 17 bears N. 2° 56' W., a distance of 1886.5 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Department of Conservation & Natural Resources, Division of State Parks
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: .01 cfs. but not to exceed 2.350 mg annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 20, 1964

Description of Works of diversion, manner, and place of use: Water is produced from a developed spring hole and pumped through a 1 1/2" diameter by 200 foot plastic pipe to a 500 gallon holding tank which is equipped with a hand pump and used for recreation and domestic purposes within the W 1/2 NE 1/4 and E 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 17, T. 5 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
