CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Albert J. Fischer (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a spring through spring and pool for recreation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T. 5 S., R. 71 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 17 bears N. 21° 06' E., a distance of 1232.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Division of State Parks
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada

* Amount of appropriation: 0058 cfs but not to exceed 1,368 mg annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 20, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use:
Water is produced by means of a developed spring hole. Water is dipped from the spring and used for recreation and domestic purposes within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, T. 5 S., R. 71 E., M. D. B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
