

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert J. Fischer (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well and hand pump for recreation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T. 5 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 21 bears N. 31° 50' W. a distance of 3400.1 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is produced by means of a drilled well and hand pump, where  
it is used for recreation and domestic purposes within the NE 1/4 SW  
Section 21, T. 5 S., R. 71 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
