CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. Joy Dougan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through a well, pump, tank and pipelines for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 20 bears S. 49° 25' W., 868.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 330.221, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.08 cfs but not to exceed 2.24 mg annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 29, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is developed by means of a well and is conveyed through a distribution system to the Trailer Trees Ranch where it is used to service 15 trailers and two houses within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
