CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. A. Moore, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pipeline and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, T. 45 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 10 bears N. 31° 17' W., a distance of 1100 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: U.S. Department of the Interior Name of appropriator Bureau of Land Management Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada Amount of appropriation 01 cfs or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle Period of use, from March 1st to December 1st of each year Date of priority of appropriation September 15, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use Water is diverted from underground by a well and pump to a trough within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, and by a 1 1/4" pipeline to a trough located within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 9, all in T. 45 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used for stockwatering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
