CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Garden Creek through dam, pump, ditches, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T. 9 N., R. 24 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears N. 37° 32' W., a distance of 1,060 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
