CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 25 N., R. 42 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 14 bears S. 43° 46' E., a distance of 143.0 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 2,498 cfs but not to exceed 1,212.75 ac. ft. per season
Period of use, from: March 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 2, 1960

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
