CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Karl F. Weikel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Clark Well) through well, pump, and watering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 28 S., R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 36 bears N. 88° 14' 00" E., 3076.5 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00557 cfs or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 18, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by well, pump and pipeline to a watering trough located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 36, where it is used to water 300 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
