CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald T. Hall, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 23 bears S. 74° 28' 17" E., 538.24 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kingsbury Water Corp.
Post-office address Stateline, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 08912 cfs but not to exceed 12,000 gal. per day.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 10, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a 6 inch main to a 500,000 gallon storage tank and comingled with other waters of the Kingsbury Water Corp.
Water is used to serve 19 lots in Foothill subdivision in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
