CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Dun Glen Creek

through an earthen dam for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 32 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 5 bears N. 45° W., a distance of 43.0 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Star Sheep Company

Post-office address Imlay, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0212 cfs. or sufficient to water 3,000 sheep and 100 cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 21, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An earthen dam approximately 50 feet by 50 feet is constructed across the channel of Dun Glen Creek where the impounded water is used for stockwatering purposes within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 32 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
