CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Creek and Tributaries through an earthen dam for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T. 32 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 29 bears N. 53° 07' W., a distance of 1,728.0 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation .007 cfs or sufficient to water 3,000 sheep and 100 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 4, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
an earthen pond approximately 50 feet by 50 feet is constructed in the Willow Creek Channel where the impounded water is used for stockwatering purposes within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T. 32 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
