

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Warm Springs, also known as Lackawanna Springs through works of diversion and pipelines for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 3 bears N. 29° 54' 21" E., a distance of 2,401.14 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ely Municipal Water Dept.
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.56 cfs
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
\*Date of priority of appropriation: November 3, 1905

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected by perforated pipes from the spring area and piped to a pump at the point of diversion. Water is then pumped to the place of use located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of said Section 3, where it is used for mining and milling purposes. Water is returned to the natural channel from the tailings ponds, located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of said Section 3.
This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit No. 21, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 21.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
