CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed springs through small pond, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T. 43 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 25 bears S. 49° 21' E., 1,160 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.080 cfs but not to exceed 39.24 ac. ft. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 10, 1963

9.81 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25, T. 43 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B.&M.
9.81 Acres Total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
