CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T. 35 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec 30, T. 35 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 82°38'02" W., a distance of 16,483.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator... Clover Livestock Company
Post-office address... Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation... 0.0125 cfs or sufficient to water 2,000 head of sheep.
Period of use, from... November 15th to May 15th of each year the following
Date of priority of appropriation... August 13, 1965

Description of WORKS of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well; thence pumped into four 21' X 2' X 20' troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 2,000 head of sheep.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
