CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, & irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 3, T. 39 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 3 bears N. 86° 35' W., a distance of 3,163 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Gerhard Miller, Jr.
Post-office address: Paradise Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.923 cfs but not to exceed 609.84 ac. ft. per season
Period of use, from: May 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 15, 1962

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.6 ac. ft. per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
