CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jim Daniels has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Spring through spring, tunnels, pipeline and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 2 S., R. 42 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE 1/4 corner of said Section 33 bears N. 1° 53' E., a distance of 3,234.0 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937. Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 333.421, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator L. C. Colvin

Post-office address Long Creek, Oregon

Amount of appropriation .005 cfs or sufficient to water 150 cattle and 10 horses.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation November 6, 1937

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is piped from the spring area through approximately 900 feet of 2 inch pipe to an iron trough 3 feet wide by 2 1/2 feet deep by 10 feet long and a 5,000 gallon storage tank which is located on the 2 inch pipe line. The place of use is within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 2 S., R. 42 E., M.D.B. & M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 10187, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 10187.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
