CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Gouge Eye Spring through pipe and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 8 N., R. 67 E., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 6 T. 8 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 38° 07' 33" W., a distance of 18,984.74 ft situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation .0016 cfs or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\*Date of priority of appropriation December 8, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use. water is diverted from spring by 8 feet of 1" pipe to a trough 10' and 10" in diameter, located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 8 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit No. 2587, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 2587.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
