CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 12, T. 35 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 12 bears N. 45° 00' W. a distance of 75.00 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Moore Equipment Company
Post-office address: Stockton, California
Amount of appropriation: 4.08 cfs but not to exceed 1330.4 ac. ft. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
\*Date of priority of appropriation: April 23, 1964

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, (and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre per year from all sources).

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 21970 hence the date of priority is that of Permit 21970.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
