

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS William T. O'Neil has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Slough No. 3 from Mose Duval and Tom Kane Creeks through Slough, diversion works and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 35 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of ~~NRS 513.010~~ ^{Sec. 72, Chap. 140, Statutes/1913} has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
