CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS G. K. Collins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rock and Indian Springs through spring, ditch, and reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, T. 6 S., R. 39 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 14, bears S. 29° 20' E., a distance of 5,729.0 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chap. 140, Statutes/1913 NRS 233.021, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0067 cfs or sufficient to water 200 cattle & 15 horses.
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 23, 1918

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a developed spring from which it is conveyed via a ditch to an earthen reservoir approximately 30 feet by 130 feet by 2 1/2 feet deep where it is used to water 200 head of cattle and 15 horses within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, T. 6 S., R. 39 E., M. D. B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
