CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 1, T. 37 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 1 bears S. 84° 35' W., a distance of 1,896.42 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 214 cfs but not to exceed 5.6 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 20, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped to a 500 gallon pressure tank; thence distributed to 48 trailer spaces, a cafe, bar and store in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, T. 37 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for commercial and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
