CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William C. Wildman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, T. 43 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 17 bears S. 1° 02' E., 2,620 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 4.41 cfs but not to exceed 621.6 ac. ft. per season.
Period of use, from: March 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 26, 1965

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
39.4 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, T. 43 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M.
38.2 " " " NE 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " " "
39.7 " " " SW 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " " "
38.1 " " " SE 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " " "
155.4 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
