CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 34) through drilled well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 12, T. 44 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 12 bears N. 46° 03' 59" W., a distance of 74.05 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Sec. 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937. NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of said Statutes, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
