The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 14 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 8, bears S. 49° 25' E., a distance of 1,645.32 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and motor and conveyed through a pipeline to a steam electric generating plant located within portions of the SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 5, T. 15 S., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for industrial cooling purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total diversion of water under this certificate and Certificates 7169, 7170, 7171, and 7172, shall not exceed 2,945 cfs and that the total annual duty under this certificate and Certificates 7169, 7170, 7171, and 7172, shall not exceed 433.0 acre feet.

This certificate is issued to correct an error in the description of the point of diversion in Certificate 7168, as recorded on January 23, 1970 in Book 005, Instrument No. 3764, Clark County Records.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
