CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, T. J. Wyche (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Collar & Elbow Springs through diversion box pipeline for transportation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T. 36 N., R. 68 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 22 bears N. 16° 53' W. a distance of 1,568.4 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140 Statutes of 1913, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Western Pacific Railroad
Post-office address: San Francisco, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.12 cfs
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 30, 1915

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is developed at the spring thence conveyed via 38,600 feet of 4 inch pipe lines to the place of use located within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 35 N., R. 68 E., M. D. B. & M., and for transportation purposes (steam locomotive).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
