CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. M. Boggio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Creek through Diversion Dam & Ditches for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T. 42 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 36 bears N. 54° 15' E., a distance of 66.0 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit. *This certificate changes the point of diversion of Proof 0702 as set forth in the Little Humboldt River Decree, Case No. 3157, in the Sixth Judicial District court; hence the priority is the same as decreed. This cert. also corrects an error in the permit pertaining to the total ac. ft. allowed in the permit. The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
