CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alfred Uhalde has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Garden Valley Well) through well, pump & watering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 1 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 35, T. 1 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 1° 54' W., a distance of 5,389.0 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Alfred Uhalde and Gracian Uhalde
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0223 cfs. or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep and 500 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 11, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from underground by means of well and pump in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 1 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., and conveyed to a 5,000-gallon tank, 15 foot cattle trough and 60 foot sheep trough located in the same subdivision, where it is used to water 5,000 sheep and 500 cattle January 1st to December 31st of each year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
