CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Hubert C. Charles - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Toulon Mill Spring through spring, diversion box & pipeline for Milling and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 35, T. 26 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T. 25 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 61° 44' E., a distance of 10,558.5 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140 Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0223 cfs
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1916

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed at the spring in a collection box thence conveyed via a 1 1/2" X 1 1/4 mile pipeline to a 7,500-gallon tank. Thence hauled to the place of use.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
